Under 2 pCi/L

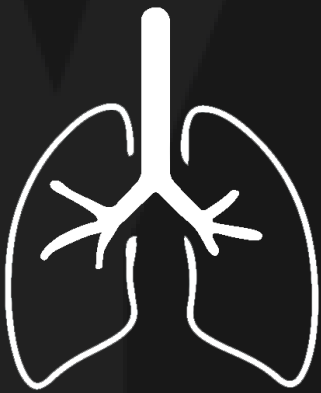

4 pCi/L and above

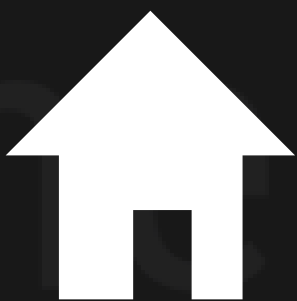
A radon level of 4 picoCuries per liter (pCi/L) or more is considered high.



IS RADON DANGEROUS?

Radon gas can damage cells in your lungs, which can lead to cancer. Radon is responsible for about 21,000 lung cancer deaths each year in the United States. The danger in radon exposure is that you cannot see it, taste it, or smell it.

Early signs and symptoms of lung cancer may include coughing up blood and chest pain, among others.



HOW TO TEST YOUR HOME FOR RADON

Radon levels can vary from one building to the next. The EPA recommends taking a short-term radon test, and if the results are 4 pCi/L or higher, then proceed with a follow-up test to make certain.
