RADON TESTING SAVES LIVES

Radon causes an estimated 15,000 to 22,000 lung cancer deaths each year. The EPA estimates that over the past 20 years, radon prevention methods have helped saved over 6,000 lives.

WEATHER CONDITIONS MATTER

Weather conditions, like storms that increase air pressure, can affect radon levels, so when testing, avoid these times.

SEASONS CAN IMPACT RADON LEVELS

Closed home conditions in winter and summer, combined with pressure fronts, can cause levels to be higher in those seasons.

RADON RESISTANT CONSTRUCTION CAN HELP

Radon levels can be lower in homes with radon resistant features, but testing is important to ensure safe levels.
